4	<ul> <li>Identifies and reports all important points and supporting details rapidly and accurately with confidence</li> <li>Shows complete understanding of main points, including relevance to message as a whole</li> <li>Identifies speaker's attitude and line of argument</li> <li>Evaluates speaker's arguments in a sophisticated way</li> </ul>
3	<ul> <li>Identifies and reports most main points and supporting details rapidly and accurately</li> <li>Shows good understanding of main points, including relevance to message as a whole</li> <li>Recognises speaker's attitude and line of argument</li> <li>Evaluates speaker's arguments</li> </ul>
2	<ul> <li>Identifies main points and reports them briefly but accurately</li> <li>Shows good understanding of information in recording, but not always their relevance to message as a whole</li> <li>Does not always grasp speaker's attitude or line of argument</li> <li>Does not always evaluate speaker's arguments</li> </ul>
1	<ul> <li>Identifies main points but incompletely or in a rather general way</li> <li>Shows some understanding of information in recording, but does not differentiate between major and minor points</li> <li>Does not recognise speaker's attitude or line of argument</li> <li>Does not evaluate speaker's arguments</li> </ul>
0	No performance to assess (eg candidate does not speak)
